Tuition, Enrollment and Payment Procedures

Step 1: Go to the CSCTFL website [csctfl.org] and select the “Register Now” button on the home page or select the *2022 Convention* tab on that website and click the “Register Now” button there. Only pre-registered convention attendees may enroll in these graduate courses.

Step 2: Registration is now open and will remain open until March 20, 2022 (one week following the conclusion of the 2022 CSCTFL convention). To register:

- ➔ Go to *World Language PD* [www.WorldLanguagePD.com/CSCTFL],
- ➔ Complete the enrollment form for either the 1-credit or the 3-credit course, and
- ➔ Complete your payment.

Once you have completed these steps, you will receive an e-mail confirmation from World Language PD. This email message will include:

- ➔ access information to the online course shell where you will upload your course work and
- ➔ information about how to create an account and order your SUU transcript.
