Schedule

All World Language PD courses are offered on a rotational basis. At minimum, six Spanish and French courses and three German and Japanese courses are offered per calendar year.

All World Language PD courses taken through NNU can be completed prior to admission to the program and later applied to the graduate certificate, thus allowing you to experience graduate coursework prior to committing to a certificate. However, it is not possible to apply World Language PD courses taken through a different university partner to the program.
